



TERMS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE EXHIBITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FORUM “SECURITY FOR THE FUTURE”

I GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1 – Purpose of the Exhibition

The Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future” is organized with the aim of:

1. Presenting products and offering services from domestic and international markets intended for the security sector.
2. Showcasing technical, technological, and other achievements in the field of security.
3. Establishing, maintaining, and developing business relations and concluding commercial agreements between exhibitors and potential buyers.
4. Promoting domestic and international trade as well as business, technical, and technological cooperation.
5. Bringing together key stakeholders from all areas of security.
6. Facilitating cooperation between public institutions, private companies, equipment manufacturers, the academic community, and professionals from practice.
7. Presenting state-of-the-art technologies, innovations, and integrated security solutions.
8. Enabling exhibitors to present their latest products, services, and solutions across all security sectors.
9. Supporting professional networking and business matchmaking.
10. Providing a platform for B2B meetings, partnerships, and the exchange of professional experience and best practices.
11. Promoting best practices, quality standards, and compliance frameworks.
12. Promoting international and European standards applicable to the security sector.
13. Supporting professional development, capacity building, and continuous education.
14. Organizing lectures, workshops, demonstrations, panel discussions, and practical presentations.
15. Encouraging the integration and interoperability of different security domains.
16. Demonstrating the functioning of security systems within modern organizations and critical infrastructures.
17. Promoting new products, services, and technological solutions.
18. Providing a platform for the launch of innovations and the presentation of solutions prior to large-scale market deployment.
19. Establishing a recognizable annual regional event of international relevance.
20. Positioning the Exhibition as a central regional meeting point for all security-related industries and stakeholders.
21. Ensuring high visibility for exhibitors, including premium positioning of brands and solutions.
22. Encouraging cross-sector cooperation, particularly between the public and private sectors, industry, and the academic and research community.

Article 2 – Eligibility of Exhibitors

Eligible exhibitors at the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future” shall be legal entities engaged in the manufacture, distribution, trade, or provision of products and services within the sectors covered by the Forum.

The categories of products and services eligible for exhibition shall be determined by the Organizer in accordance with the official Exhibition program. The exhibition of products or services outside the defined scope of the program shall not be permitted.

II CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Article 3.

Retail sale of goods at the Exhibition shall be permitted, provided that such activities are conducted in full compliance with applicable national legislation and relevant EU regulations.

Exhibitors may participate in the Exhibition in their own name and for their own account, or on behalf of and/or for the account of another legal entity, subject to prior notification and approval by the Organizer.

The allocated exhibition space may not be transferred, assigned, or subleased to third parties, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of the Organizer.

The Exhibitor shall be entitled to display the names of co-exhibitors and indirect exhibitors at its exhibition stand only if such entities have been duly registered with the Organizer.

If the Exhibitor fails to register co-exhibitors or indirect exhibitors, or submits incomplete or inaccurate information in its application, the Organizer shall be entitled to subsequently charge the Exhibitor the applicable co-exhibitor and/or indirect exhibitor registration fees.

III SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS, ALLOCATION OF EXHIBITION SPACE, SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Article 4.

1. Participation in the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future” shall be subject to the submission of an Application for Participation, using the official forms issued by the Organizer, which are also available on the official website of the International Forum “Security for the Future”.

2. Applications for Participation must be signed by the Exhibitor or by a duly authorized representative, in which case the authorization shall form an integral part of the Application. Applications must bear the official company stamp used in the Exhibitor’s business correspondence, unless the Exhibitor has formally decided not to use a company stamp in its business operations.

3. All fields and sections contained in the Application forms shall be completed by the Exhibitor.

4. Applications for Participation shall be deemed legally binding contracts concluded between the Applicant and the Organizer.

ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS

Article 5

1. The Organizer reserves the right to accept or reject any Application for Participation and, with regard to the size of the exhibition space, to increase or reduce the requested area depending on availability and the potential location of the exhibition space.
2. The Organizer shall decide on the acceptance or rejection of an Application for Participation within five (5) days from the date of receipt and official registration of the Application in the Organizer's records and shall notify the Applicant thereof in writing.
3. If the Organizer fails to notify the Applicant of its decision within the deadline specified in paragraph 2 of this Article, the Application for Participation shall be deemed accepted.
4. The Exhibitor may withdraw the submitted Application for Participation only within five (5) days from the date of submission, provided that the Organizer has not meanwhile confirmed receipt and acceptance of the Application in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Article.
5. If the Exhibitor withdraws the Application after the expiry of the above-mentioned deadline or after confirmation of acceptance, the Exhibitor shall be obliged to pay the Organizer the rental fee for the applied exhibition space, as well as any other costs incurred as a result of the Exhibitor's withdrawal. In duly justified cases, the Organizer may, at its discretion, release the Exhibitor from this obligation in whole or in part.
6. In the event of withdrawal by the Exhibitor, the Organizer reserves the right to freely dispose of the allocated exhibition space that was subject to the lease.
7. The Application for Participation shall have the legal force and effect of a contract.

ALLOCATION OF EXHIBITION SPACE

Article 6

1. The Organizer shall allocate exhibition space and determine the exhibition location for each Exhibitor. The Organizer reserves the right, where this is deemed to be in the interest of the Exhibition of the International Forum "Security for the Future", to relocate an Exhibitor from an already allocated exhibition space to another location.
2. Exhibition space allocation shall be carried out according to the principle of grouping exhibitors from the same or related industries, or exhibiting similar or related products or exhibits, or based on other criteria determined by the Organizer.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE EXHIBITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FORUM "SECURITY FOR THE FUTURE"

Article 7

1. The period during which the leased exhibition space may be used prior to the opening and after the closing of the exhibition event shall be determined by the Organizer, who shall timely inform the registered exhibitors thereof.
2. The Organizer shall provide each Exhibitor with information regarding the allocated exhibition space, including a corresponding layout plan of such space.

3. The Exhibitor undertakes to comply with the official opening, closing, and working hours of the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future”, and in particular to ensure that the exhibition stand with exhibits remains fully operational until the official closing of the Exhibition.

4. In the event of non-compliance with paragraph 3 of this Article, as officially recorded by the hall inspector, the Exhibitor shall be obliged to pay penalties in accordance with the Organizer’s price list, amounting to 20% of the exhibition space rental fee.

IV EXHIBITION SPACE RENTAL FEES AND SERVICE PRICES

Article 8

1. The Organizer shall determine the rental fees for exhibition space and the individual prices of services. By signing the Application for Participation, the Application for Exhibition Space Rental, and/or requests for additional services, the Exhibitor accepts the prices and conditions set by the Organizer.
2. The exhibition space rental fee and the use of the Organizer’s services shall be paid in the manner and under the conditions specified in the applications referred to in Article 9.
3. The exhibition space rental fee shall be calculated based on the gross surface area of the allocated exhibition space. Each commenced square meter shall be charged as a full square meter.
4. Any objections or complaints regarding invoices issued by the Organizer may be submitted only within seven (7) days from the date of receipt of the invoice.

V CONTRACTING AND METHOD OF PAYMENT

Article 9

1. The Exhibitor undertakes to make advance payment, based on the pro forma invoice, for the exhibition space and additional services within five (5) days from the invoice issuance date. Payment collection shall be secured in accordance with the applicable Law on Payment Transactions.
2. In the event of late payment beyond the agreed deadline, the Exhibitor shall be charged interest in accordance with the officially published statutory default interest rate. If the applicable default interest rate is not known at the time of calculation, the index from the previous month shall be applied.

VI LEASE AND FIT-OUT OF EXHIBITION SPACE

Article 10

1. All exhibition stands shall be standard modular stands. Complete assembly and disassembly shall be organized by the Organizer of the International Forum “Security for the Future”, in cooperation with the company providing the stands. Assembly of stands shall commence on 13 September 2026 at 07:30 a.m., and disassembly shall take place after the working hours of the Exhibition, no later than 16 September 2026 at 03:30 p.m.

2. Exhibitors may bring their promotional materials to their stands starting on 14 September 2026 at 07:30 a.m. If Exhibitors intend to install larger product samples on their stands, such installation must be agreed in advance with the Organizer and completed by 13 September 2026 at 08:00 p.m. After the official opening of the Exhibition on 14 September 2026 at 10:00 a.m., the installation of larger samples on stands shall not be permitted.
3. Leased stand elements must not be damaged (drilled, cut, painted, bent, or otherwise physically altered in a manner that changes the appearance or quality of the material), nor removed from the stand or the exhibition hall. In the event of damage, the Exhibitor shall be obliged to pay compensation equal to the value of the lost element for all damage, including accidental damage, as well as 100% of the rental price for loss of profit. All damages shall be recorded in an official report prepared by the Organizer.
4. After completion of stand assembly and handover prior to the opening of the event, no complaints shall be accepted.

Article 11

1. Each stand in the exhibition space allocation plan shall have a unique stand number, the registered name and location of the Exhibitor and co-exhibitor, the allocated floor area, and marked locations of electrical power connections and fire protection hydrants.
2. Company name signage of Exhibitors shall be placed on the front of the stand. If a stand has multiple open sides, signage must be placed on each side.
3. During the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future”, packaging materials must not be left outside the stand or in any other visible location, except in the manner предусмотрен for hall and stand cleaning during the Exhibition.
4. Exhibitors are obliged to comply within their stands with the principles of fair competition, proper business conduct, and the established house rules. The following are prohibited:
 - * Loud demonstrations and presentations of companies, programs, or products without prior notification to and approval by the Organizer;
 - * Announcements, publications, or advertising activities that disturb other exhibitors;
 - * Conflicts with competitors, other staff, or visitors of the Exhibition.
5. The use of audio electronic devices producing a noise level exceeding 50 dB is not permitted at the stand.
6. Electrical power connection at the stand shall be provided by the Organizer after inspection of the installation carried out by the Exhibitor. If the Exhibitor requires installed power exceeding 1 kW, this must be announced in due time in the Application so that the exhibition electrical service can provide an appropriate connection. If the installation does not comply with technical regulations, the power connection shall not be granted until the installation is brought into technical compliance. After the connection is provided with the specified technical capacity, whether for stand lighting or demonstration of exhibits, the Exhibitor may not modify or extend the installation, nor exceed the permitted power capacity.

7. The Exhibitor is obliged to maintain all installations, equipment, exhibits, and the stand in proper working condition. The Exhibitor shall ensure that all persons engaged at the stand are informed of occupational safety measures related to the use of electrically powered equipment.

8. Flammable materials may not be used for stand decoration. The distance between lighting sources and flammable surfaces must not be less than 40 cm. The use of heating devices and compressors in exhibition halls is prohibited.

9. In the event of non-compliance with any of the above technical conditions, the Exhibitor shall bear the following consequences:

- * All objects and stand elements not compliant with the technical conditions shall be immediately dismantled at the Exhibitor's expense;

- * All damages shall be charged in accordance with an assessment determined by a designated commission.

10. During the official working hours of the Exhibition, no parallel or additional works at the stand shall be permitted. The attachment and display of decorative materials within the Exhibitor's own stand shall be allowed only if such materials can be removed without residue (adhesive, tape, etc.). Drilling of modular partition walls and the use of nails, hooks, screws, or similar fixtures is strictly prohibited.

Article 12

1. The exhibition space shall be returned to the Organizer in the condition in which it was handed over to the Exhibitor for use. This means that the Exhibitor is obliged to remove all materials, exhibits, equipment, and all other items from the leased exhibition space in full, without residue. The removal of any damage shall be borne by the Exhibitor.

2. Any damage incurred during the Exhibitor's use of the exhibition space shall be assessed by a commission appointed by the Organizer, in the mandatory presence of an authorized representative of the Exhibitor. In the event of unjustified absence of the Exhibitor's representative, the Organizer shall independently determine the damage by means of an official commission report.

3. Outside the official working hours of the Exhibition of the International Forum "Security for the Future", supervision of exhibition spaces and safeguarding of exhibits shall be ensured by the Organizer and the Exhibitors in coordination with the hall inspection service, with the obligation that Exhibitors strictly comply with the prescribed working hours and deadlines for the removal of exhibits.

VII EXHIBITS

Article 13

1. For exhibits displayed in indoor exhibition areas whose height exceeds 3 meters, or which have large dimensions and weight, or impose a load exceeding 500 kg/m² on the floor structure, the Exhibitor shall be obliged to submit detailed information on the dimensions and weight of such exhibits together with the Application for Participation.



2. The Exhibitor shall implement all necessary safety and security measures to protect persons, as well as the property of the Organizer and third parties, from risks that may arise during the installation, exhibition, and dismantling of exhibits. Exhibits for which the required safety measures have not been provided shall not be permitted to be exhibited at the event.
3. The Exhibitor shall not place exhibits outside the exhibition space leased by the Exhibitor.
4. If prototypes of certain products are exhibited, this must be clearly indicated on the exhibit.
5. For exhibits intended for retail sale and displayed for that purpose in designated exhibition areas, the retail prices must be clearly and visibly displayed on each exhibit.
6. The leased exhibition space may be used to store promotional and advertising materials, professional literature, and appropriate technical equipment necessary for the Exhibitor's activities.
7. During the assembly, furnishing, and dismantling of the stand, as well as during the official working hours of the Exhibition, the Exhibitor shall, at its own expense, independently or through the Organizer, ensure safeguarding of the exhibits at the stand. Outside the official working hours of the Exhibition of the International Forum "Security for the Future", supervision of exhibition spaces and safeguarding of exhibited items shall be ensured by the Organizer.

VIII INSURANCE

Article 14

1. The Exhibitor shall be obliged to independently arrange insurance coverage for all exhibits and other property displayed or used during the Exhibition of the International Forum "Security for the Future", including insurance against theft, damage, destruction, and other risks.
2. The insurance referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article shall cover the entire period during which the property is present at the Exhibition venue, starting from unloading, through assembly, the duration of the Exhibition, dismantling, and until loading for transport and removal.
3. The Exhibitor shall arrange insurance coverage directly, through an insurance company in the country or abroad, at its own discretion.
4. If the Exhibitor fails to arrange insurance in accordance with this Article, the Exhibitor shall bear full and exclusive risk and liability for any damage incurred to exhibits or other property.
5. The Organizer shall not, under any circumstances, be liable for any damage, accident, or injury that may occur to Exhibitors, co-exhibitors, or persons engaged by them during any phase of the Exhibition of the International Forum "Security for the Future".

IX SALE OF EXHIBITED GOODS

Article 15

1. The conclusion of sales contracts for goods exhibited at the Exhibition of the International Forum "Security for the Future" shall be permitted, as well as retail sales of consumer goods, in accordance with applicable legal regulations. Sold goods may not be removed from the Exhibition or from the stand prior to the official closing of the Exhibition, except for goods sold at retail.

2. All formalities related to the purchase and customs clearance of foreign goods shall be carried out by domestic buyers and foreign exhibitors, respectively, or by their authorized representatives or engaged freight forwarders.

X EXHIBITOR PASSES AND ADMISSION TICKETS

Article 16

1. During access control at the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future”, Exhibitors shall use exhibitor passes, which entitle the holder to free and unrestricted entry.
2. Exhibitors participating in the Exhibition shall be entitled to a number of additional exhibitor passes proportional to the leased exhibition space.
3. Co-exhibitors exhibiting within the exhibition space leased by the primary Exhibitor shall be entitled to one free exhibitor pass, based on their participation applications.
4. Additional exhibitor passes and admission tickets may be purchased at the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future”, in accordance with the official price list.
5. In the event of misuse, the Organizer reserves the right to revoke the exhibitor pass from the user.

XII REPRESENTATION AND ADVERTISING

Article 17

1. Exhibitors shall be entitled to use advertising and representation tools within the Organizer’s premises, in accordance with the provisions of these Rules.
2. The following forms of advertising and representation shall be available to Exhibitors:
 - * Placement of advertisements on designated surfaces and structures within the Exhibition venue;
 - * Other forms of Organizer-provided representation (displays, video presentations, etc.);
 - * Distribution of the Exhibitor’s own leaflets and promotional samples at the stand;
 - * Distribution of the Exhibitor’s own leaflets and promotional samples outside the stand.
3. The conditions for the use of advertising services referred to in paragraph 2 of this Article shall be determined by the official price list of the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future” or agreed separately.
4. Without prior written consent of the Organizer, Exhibitors shall not be permitted to install their own advertising elements or use other forms of advertising within the Exhibition venue.
5. Without prior written consent of the Organizer, Exhibitors shall not be permitted to install advertising elements or use other forms of advertising of third parties with whom they have any form of business cooperation (including POS materials) within the Exhibition venue.



6. Without the prior written consent of the Organizer, Exhibitors shall not be permitted, within the Organizer's premises—and in particular at their own stands (leased exhibition spaces)—to carry out or allow third parties to carry out promotional activities for the benefit of third parties with whom the Exhibitors have concluded any form of business cooperation. This includes, but is not limited to, the free distribution of promotional materials, beverages, food, or similar items for the purpose of promotion and advertising.
7. Any contracts or agreements concluded by Exhibitors with third parties for the purpose of advertising or promoting such third parties shall not be binding upon, nor shall they produce any legal effect with respect to, the Organizer under any circumstances.
8. Audio advertising and music may be used within the Exhibitor's stand only provided that such use does not interfere with the business activities of other Exhibitors. The timing and duration of special promotions, visitor programs, and similar activities at the stand must be reported to the Organizer in advance.
9. For all of the above-mentioned forms of advertising and representation, only business-related advertising and representation in accordance with the International Code of Advertising Practice (ICC Code) shall be permitted.
10. The Exhibitor may give interviews exclusively within its own stand area or in the designated press room.
11. Advertising posters (except those placed within the Exhibitor's own stand) may be displayed only in areas specifically designated for that purpose.

XIII RECORDING OF EXHIBITS AND FILM SCREENINGS

Article 16

1. Recording and photography for advertising purposes at the Exhibition, for the needs of Exhibitors, shall be carried out by a person engaged by the Exhibitor to record its stand, under the conditions determined by the Organizer.
2. The Organizer reserves the right, free of charge, to photograph and record exhibits and stands. The Organizer also reserves the right to publish reproductions of such recordings without charge and to publicly display recorded materials or use them for other purposes. In the event that copyright or related rights protection applies to the exhibited equipment, devices, or any part thereof, the Exhibitor shall be obliged to inform the Organizer in advance of any prohibition on recording or photography.

XIV OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH MEASURES DURING THE PREPARATION AND DURATION OF THE EXHIBITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FORUM "SECURITY FOR THE FUTURE"

Article 17

Prior to the opening of the Exhibition, the Organizer's occupational safety and health professional shall inspect the stand installations in order to assess compliance with occupational safety and health requirements.

The following shall be strictly prohibited:

1. Bringing in any substances or materials that may pose a risk to human life, health, or material assets.
2. Undertaking any activities that may endanger the life or health of persons at the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future”.
3. Access to areas not designated for use in connection with the Exhibition.
4. Any manipulation of electrical devices or electrical installations that may endanger human life or health.
5. Entry into the exhibition premises without passing through security control gates.
6. Presence within the exhibition premises without visibly displayed accreditation.
7. Re-entry into the exhibition premises without presenting accreditation to security personnel.
8. Any activities involving discrimination on any grounds.
9. Failure to observe fire protection measures.
10. Failure by Exhibitors to provide adequate fire protection equipment when exhibiting materials or equipment that may pose a fire hazard.
11. In the event of danger requiring evacuation, all persons must comply with the evacuation plan and follow instructions issued by authorized personnel.
12. Failure to comply with the requirements and instructions of the hall inspector.

XV POWERS OF THE ORGANIZER

Article 18

The Organizer reserves the right to:

1. Cancel or change the date of the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future”, with the obligation to notify registered Exhibitors at least one (1) month prior to the originally scheduled date. If registered Exhibitors do not cancel their participation in writing within five (5) days of receipt of the notification, they shall be deemed to have accepted the new date. In the event of a change of date, the agreed prices shall not be reduced.
2. Extend or limit the duration of the Exhibition or the range of products eligible for exhibition, and to designate press days, commercial days, and visiting hours.
3. Determine the prices of exhibition space, services, and admission tickets.
4. Remove, at the Exhibitor’s cost and risk, any exhibits that may endanger persons or damage property if the Exhibitor fails to implement the required safety measures.
5. Prohibit the demonstration of exhibits if the necessary safety measures have not been implemented.
6. Prohibit the entry of exhibits exceeding permitted height or weight limits if such data were not specified in the Application for Participation and confirmed by the Organizer.

7. Remove advertising materials and advertising structures placed outside designated areas.
8. Remove from the stand any Exhibitor personnel who fail to comply with exhibition rules and, at the Exhibitor's expense, appoint replacement personnel until suitable staff arrive.
9. Suspend the participation of an Exhibitor who, despite prior warnings, fails to comply with the provisions of these General Rules, particularly in the following cases:
 - * Exhibiting items outside the leased exhibition space;
 - * Failure to maintain the stand in proper condition during the Exhibition;
 - * Failure to ensure the presence of personnel at the stand during official working hours;
 - * Interfering with the activities of other participants or visitors, particularly through excessive use of internal sound systems exceeding exhibition standards (maximum 50 dB);
 - * Allowing the removal of exhibits during the Exhibition, except for items sold at retail;
 - * Using advertising materials that are not of a business nature or that are contrary to the International Code of Advertising Practice.
10. Prescribe and charge penalties for violations of specific provisions of these General Rules.
11. Appoint legal entities authorized to provide additional services on behalf of the Organizer (freight forwarding, direct marketing, catering, logistics, accommodation, tourism services, etc.).

XVI COMPENSATION FOR DAMAGES

Article 19

1. The Organizer shall not be liable for any damage incurred by Exhibitors as a result of the Organizer exercising its rights in cases provided for under these General Rules.
2. The Organizer and the Exhibitors shall be entitled to compensation for damages resulting from violations of these General Rules on Participation in the Exhibition, in accordance with the provisions of the Law on Obligations of the Republic of Serbia.

XVII JURISDICTION

Article 20

The legal relations between the Organizer and the Exhibitor shall be governed by the applicable legislation of the Republic of Serbia.

Any disputes arising between the Organizer and the Exhibitor shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent court in Belgrade.



XVIII BINDING NATURE OF THE GENERAL RULES

Article 21

These General Rules on Participation in the Exhibition of the International Forum “Security for the Future” shall constitute an integral part of the Application Agreement for Participation, the Application for Renting Exhibition Space, and the Application for Additional Services at the Exhibition.

The provisions of these General Rules shall be binding upon the Organizer and the Exhibitors / Co-Exhibitors.
